.22 CAL. AMMUNITION, AIR PELLET AND BB PURCHASE PROGRAM FOR CMP AFFILIATES

INSTRUCTIONS: The CMP .22 Cal. Ammunition, Air Pellet and BB Purchase Program allows CMP affiliated organizations (which includes all JROTC teams; BSA camps, troops and crews; 4-H clubs or camps and youth camps with rifle marksmanship programs) to purchase ammunition suitable for junior marksmanship instruction and target practice at special prices. Please use this form to order rimfire smallbore ammunition, air rifle pellets and BBs at any time during the year. Unlimited quantities of any item may be purchased as long as they are ordered by an organization affiliated with the CMP. Orders should be submitted at least 30 days before the items are required to allow sufficient time for order processing and shipping (please see estimated delivery times below for .22 ammo). Please review the instructions and information on the back of this form before ordering.

PLEASE NOTE: All ammo orders require proof of citizenship ie: copy of birth certificate or passport.

Additional Information

- ⊙ **CMP Ammunition, Air Pellet and BB Purchase Program.** This program is part of CMP efforts to make .22-caliber ammunition, air rifle pellets and BBs, which are especially suitable for youth firearm safety and rifle marksmanship programs, available at the lowest possible prices. The CMP does this through volume purchase contracts and subsidized prices. Eligibility to purchase smallbore ammunition, air rifle pellets or BBs through this program is restricted to organizations affiliated with the CMP who have junior shooting programs.
- ⊙ **Affiliated Organizations.** All JROTC units, BSA Councils and County Extension Agents with 4-H Shooting Sports Clubs in their counties are automatically counted as CMP affiliates as a result of agreements the CMP has made with the Army Cadet Command, Naval Education and Training Command, USMC Training and Education Command, AFOATS, Boy Scouts of America and National 4-H Shooting Sports. Local units of each of these organizations may purchase rimfire ammunition, air pellets or BBs at the prices listed in this bulletin for use in their youth marksmanship activities.
- ⊙ **Maximum Order Amounts.** There are no maximum order amounts. As long as the ammunition, pellets or BBs are used by an authorized organization for youth firearms safety and marksmanship, the purchasing organization may order as many shipping units as they require for their program.
- ⊙ **Order Deadlines.** There are no deadlines for sending orders to the CMP. Orders may be submitted any time during the year, but should be submitted at least 30 days before the items are required to allow sufficient time for order processing and shipping. ***PLEASE NOTE THE ESTIMATED DELIVERY TIME IS 6 – 12 MONTHS FOR .22 AMMO.*** Prices are subject to change without notice. Affiliates will be notified of significant price differences before orders are processed.
- ⊙ **Sales Restrictions.** Organizations that order this ammunition may issue it without charge to individual participants in their programs or they may charge individual users reasonable prices for the ammunition they use, provided it is not resold for a profit. None of this ammunition may be resold at a profit to individuals or for any commercial purpose. Organizations that violate this restriction will lose their privileges to make future purchases through this program.
- ⊙ **Smallbore Ammunition.** The smallbore ammunition available through this program is “standard velocity” .22 cal. rimfire ammunition. Ammunition loadings generate chamber pressures that are well within SAAMI standards. This ammunition must meet accuracy standards established by the CMP requiring test groups that would consistently score tens on the 50-foot A-36 target. This ammunition has consistently met this standard in factory and CMP testing. . The Aguila .22 LR (NLU 419ASVSE and 419ASVGE) come in cases of 5,000 rounds. They are standard velocity .40gr solid bullet.
- ⊙ **Match Grade Pellets.** The match (competition) grade .177 cal. pellets available through this program are competition grade pellets manufactured by Vogel (Merlin). Competition (match) grade .177-caliber pellets available through the CMP must meet accuracy standards that require test groups that are significantly better than ten-ring groups on the 10-meter competition air rifle targets. These pellets consistently met this standard in factory and CMP testing.
- ⊙ **BBs.** The BBs available through this program are “Premium Grade” BBs. CMP testing of these BBs is done to ensure they are capable of producing ten-ring groups on the 5-meter BB gun competition target in target-grade BB guns. These are sold in cases only (12 cartons of 2,500 BBs).
- ⊙ **Shipping Information.** BBs, pellets and ammunition may be shipped either from CMP warehouses or directly from the manufacturer.
- ⊙ **Picking Up Ammunition at CMP.** Affiliates also have the option of picking up ammunition at the CMP warehouses at Camp Perry, Ohio (Port Clinton) or Anniston, Alabama. This will eliminate shipping charges for smallbore ammunition or air rifle pellets, however, affiliates will have to pay OH or AL sales tax unless a tax-exempt certificate for OH or AL, or 501(c) (3) document is provided when picking up the order.
